The Blood Reserve covers 540 square miles and is located in the southern portion of the province of Alberta. The Blood Indians are a part of the nation called Blackfeet or Blackfoot. The Blood call themselves *Nitsitapi*, the Real People, or *Ahkainah*, or *Kainah* meaning "Many Chiefs". The people, feeling a need for a learning, teaching, and participating society to preserve their culture, organized the Kai-Spai Society in 1970. The Kai - Spai Society sponsors many social gatherings that are conducive to teaching and learning the culture of the Nitsitapi. Pow wows are their most popular activity today. Pow wow dance is highly individualistic although there are common steps and common body movements. Singers compose hundreds of pow wow songs every year and usually, at a pow wow, you will not hear the same song twice.
