THE CODY FAMILY

The Navajo Shoe Game is played during the night. It is mostly played for creation, but may be performed as a chanting ceremony. It is played only during the winter, and sometimes into late spring. The first shoe game song was played by the day and night animals to decide if there should be only a day or night. Neither side won, therefore there is night and day. It is a counting game and yucca reeds are used to keep score. The team with all the yucca reeds are the winners.
